Physical Development

As the weather changes the children will continue to have access to the outdoor area to develop their motor skills so please ensure they have appropriate clothing (waterproofs, wellies etc)

We will be developing our range of movements and creating patterns of movements in our play. We will also develop our ball skills and practice throwing and catching different sized balls.

We will develop our fine motor skills through exploring mark making tools. We will be specifically developing our scissors skills and learning how to safely make snips with the scissors.

Communication and Language

Throughout our daily story and rhyme times we will be building up our knowledge of stories and rhymes. The children will be learning to retell familiar stories and recall characters and events.

We will also begin to create our own stories through our story acting sessions.



Expressive Art and Design

We will continue to learn nursery rhymes and add actions and music to our performances.

We will explore printing to create poppy pictures for Remembrance Day.



We will continue our colour mixing journey to create starry night pictures.

Understanding the World

As we learn about the many festivals at this time of year we will talk about how they are celebrated and we will begin to notice similarities in our celebrations.

The children will talk about special events in their lives and recall events from the past beginning to use the correct tense.



Mathematics

We will continue to learn number rhymes counting forwards within 5.

During our Maths small groups we will find out all about the numbers 1-3 and the different ways they can be represented. Creating number lands and counting accurately.



We will also learn about how to measure length, height and weight through comparing objects and baking.

We will learn about simple 2 part patterns and create party hats with our pattern.
