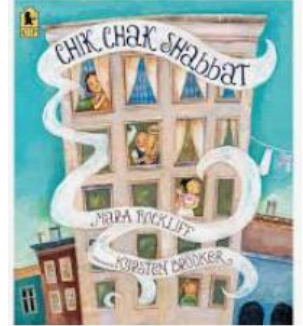
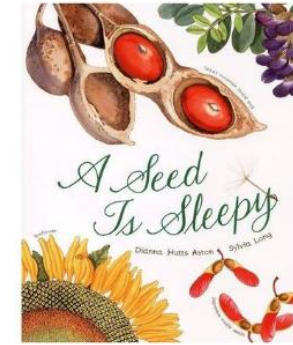
RE
